

COVID Guidelines Committee Meeting March 15, 2021

The committee agreed the guidelines worked well for our patrol. The hill was very busy all year and our guidelines kept all the crews and patrollers safe.

The group discussed the new CDC guidelines about small groups gathering who have all been vaccinated. It was agreed:

- LPR is public. We will continue with masks and guidelines recognizing that many of our skiing public are from areas in which the variants have been identified. Masks are optional in LPR unless skiing public is present.
- Masks are no longer necessary in the UPR. If unvaccinated patrollers are present and of low risk for COVID, then masks are optional and distancing is maintained.
- Only current patrollers will continue to be permitted in the UPR and LPR as current guidelines state.
- Potlucks continue to be at the discretion of each shift.
- It is important that we maintain the same cleanliness standards and guidelines set forth in the original document.
- While the CDC has lessened some of its restrictions, the GPSP will continue to follow the guidelines set forth by this committee.
