

Granite Peak Ski Patrol
Youth Protection Training
Approved 10.12.21 Board of Directors

To comply with and exceed requirements set by the National Ski Patrol Policies and Procedures, Chapter 13, the GPSP Board of Directors approved the following:

- By December 31, 2021, Patrol Representative, Assistant Patrol Representative, OEC/S&T Instructors and Slope Leaders must take an NSP approved youth protection training and submit certificate to the Division Director/Assistant Division Director **and** the GPSP Patrol Representative.
- By November, 2022, all adult patrollers on the GPSP will complete the required training and submit to the Division Director/Assistant Division Director **and** the GPSP Patrol Representative.

The approved trainings include:

- Armatus online training through Praesidium, including the following modules (fee):
 - Duty to Report
 - Preventing Sexual Activity among Adolescents
 - Meet Sam
- Safesport.org training (fee)
- The Scouts BSA youth protection training (free).
- In-person training provided by school districts, child-care centers, or other in-person training of at least 2 hours in length where a documentation is provided.

The training is valid for 3 years and must be retaken prior to the expiration of the 3-year period for continued participation in activities where protected parties are present.
